Nearly one-quarter of PS 73 students are ELL status (compared to 15.9% citywide), however only 6.1% of PS 73 ELL students attained English proficiency in the 2004-05 school year, nearly 5% below the citywide average. No ELL student in PS 73 passed the New York State ELA exam.

In terms of the ELE reading test for students in bilingual programs who receive language arts instruction in Spanish, 75.4% performed at or above grade level. This is 17% higher than the citywide average of 58.4%.
